Have high cholesterol or at risk for heart disease?

You may be eligible for a clinical trial evaluating a **potential new medication for heart disease**.

The study medication is designed to lower specific types of harmful fats in the blood that current medications don't target effectively - with the aim of reducing heart attacks, strokes, and the need for procedures.

What's Involved?

- 9-month study, with 8 clinic visits and 7 video/phone check-ins
- Injections every 2 or 4 weeks
- Health monitoring, blood tests, ECGs, and questionnaires
- All study-related care and medication at no cost
- Close support from our clinical team, and coordination with your regular doctor

- People aged 18-75
- Have high cholesterol or triglycerides
